Principal's Report

Encouraging kids to get to school on-time and reacclimate to school (knows many families have been negatively impacted by the pandemic)

Mask Opt-Out:

- 20% of Students (530) have opted out, more expected to have opted out, not as many as predicted
- Procedure: Form (issued by district) can be found on website (insert website here) which can be filled out by parent electronically and is inputted into a district database and will show up on their gradebook (will make sure that students who did not opt out continue to wear their mask)
- Trying to keep distance at schools (keep events at a specific capacity).
- Student can only access bottle refill stations, other school safety protocols still being kept in place, students with health concerns are advised to wear masks and maintain social distancing
- Field trips continue to adhere to district guidelines
- Guidance from District
- I have to check what she just said (will fact-check) Guidance from the district regarding elementary schools may also have changed.
- o COVID-19 Cases
- COVID-19 cases have gone down. Some weeks there are no positives.
- Quarantine rules have changed (only for those directly next to those who tested positive)
- Students are able to bring in proof of vaccination and no symptoms in order to avoid a quarantine period.
- Staff is not allowed to keep/make copies of vaccination information.
- Teachers will continue to work with seating charts as COVID-19 guidelines change.
- Students will NOT be segregated within their classrooms based on mask or unmasked.
- The district strongly suggests that those who are unvaccinated wear a mask and that those who are unmasked imply that they are vaccinated.
